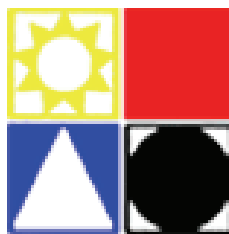

**Forum Art Fest** – means it's time for our 42nd Annual Art Exhibition & Sale

When: June 15 – 17; Friday from 3 – 9, Saturday from 11 – 7, Sunday from 11 – 4 with our official opening at 1:00 on Saturday.

## Calling all Students from September 2006 to June 2007:

If you took classes or workshops this is your opportunity to show off your artwork.

**What do we need from you?** Your art needs to be in by Friday, June 8th, 3:00 if it is a medium to be hung (watercolour, drawing, acrylic, w.s. oil). It must be wired ready to hang or at least shrinkwrapped if it's watercolour. If you have clay pieces they can be brought in June 11 to 13.

**How many pieces?** A minimum of 3 pieces for each student and probably many more as not all students (particularly the beginners) are ready to put their work into an exhibition. If you have more watercolours or cards – they can be in a clean white box for people to flip through. For clay – lots – we'll pull out as many tables as we can fit in comfortably.

**Does the work need a label?** Yes – show tags are on the office desk – if not available attach something to your work with the following information: Your name, title of the work, medium & price. If the art is remaining in your own collection or a family gift label it n.f.s.

**How is payment made by the buyer?** By cash or cheque payable to the artist.

**Can the buyer take home their purchase immediately?** Yes – this is a new idea for the Forum Art but we decided that the buyer may want something immediately so they can take it off display with help from our volunteers unless it's a very large canvas or they choose to pick it up later.

**Can you help advertise?** Yes – there are posters, invitations & business card size ads on the front ledge of the office – help yourself. You may need permission for posting at various sites – please ask.

**Does the Forum Art charge a fee for your art submissions?** No – there is no cost to have your art in our exhibition. We ask all students for 2 things in lieu of an entry fee. That you make a 20% commission contribution to the Forum Art for any items sold & that you volunteer some time & energy to help run this event.

**What are volunteers needed for?** Many things – for cleaning up the facilities, washing tables, setting up display equipment, hanging paintings, being available during the show – making coffee & putting out snacks, welcoming patrons, putting names in for door prizes, selling raffle tickets, handling cash & cheques, writing receipts, for taking purchases down, wrapping items, taking down the show, putting equipment back.

**How do I sign up to volunteer?** There's a sign up sheet at the front entry at the Forum. If you can't make it in – please call at 235-1069.

**When can I pick up my unsold items?** On the Monday or Thursday after the show or if it's on the walls don't rush – we don't move them. Sometimes buyers are still interested in shopping after the exhibition.
