

Children's Art (7 – 11 years) - Multi-Media

This class will give children the chance to experience both structured & casual time exploring various mediums.

The classes will include:

- ☞ All students will learn different exercises & techniques in drawing for at least 2 weeks using various materials such as pencil, charcoal, etc.
- ☞ We may spend some time learning how to cartoon.
- ☞ Our sculptural materials may include paper mache, clay, and collage of a variety of mediums. Any firing of clay pieces of is done on site & will be either glazed or painted by the students.
- ☞ The students are required to help set up & present their art show & work on their art during the 9th week. This is an opportunity for family members to join them for the duration of the show.
- ☞ The last class is usually used to finish up any artwork.

Materials List:

- Objects or pictures of your choice may be wanted for drawing subjects.
- Most supplies are included in your fee – some recyclables may be requested by the instructor to be used for various projects. We will have a list of some of the items. Such as: magazines, plastic containers, rags or found objects.
- Optional materials – the student may want a sketchbook to practice or continue with art work at home.

Parents are invited to stay during any of the classes with their children. They will be asked to volunteer for assisting the instructor with art related tasks. The lunchroom & library is always open if you want to relax & read while they're here.

Creators of the Future Art Show

On the 9th week of each 10-week session the instructors assist the children & teens in holding their own art show. The students can show or sell their work if they choose. Students are expected to attend during the show & should invite family & friends. At the end of the session all art work is to go home with them.
