

**Drawing for Teens – Beginners/ Intermediate**

Drawing is the foundation of all art.

This class is just for teens 13 to 17. In this class you will learn the importance of mark making to get a larger range of depth in your drawings. We will do short introductions into still life, figure drawing, perspective drawing and life drawing. The class will also give lessons on building of shape, shading and texture as well as different art styles and techniques.

The main focus of the class is to experiment and explore your creative side and have fun expressing yourself. I hope to inspire and to let all students know that anything goes in the world of creativity. I encourage this and believe that experimentation is the basic roots of making art.

*Materials List:*

- various lead pencils ( H, HB, B1, B2, B4, B6 ) – bring what you have & we'll discuss it at the first class
- kneadable eraser
- pencil sharpener
- sketch pad – not much smaller than 12” x 15”
- pad of newsprint paper
- other materials can be added such as charcoal, pastels – discuss with instructor
- may want a backing board for drawing (*can be borrowed or purchased at Forum*)
