Inspiration is key when doing art. It can come from many places including an art gallery setting.

This class is designed with that in mind. We will be meeting each week at a scheduled gallery to have a tour of the gallery and experience the art that is currently on display. You will be given the chance to talk with the gallery personnel & in some cases the artists themselves. You will be introduced to new and historic art & get an insiders view at what it takes to be a part of a gallery & what is new & exciting in art. After the tour we will then have about half an hour for discussion and sketching time to inspire your ideas in your own work.

Throughout the weeks we will have a chance to explore various facets of what makes up a gallery show. Art can encompass collections such as permanent, travelling, Manitoban, Canadian, contemporary, performance, video & audio installations. Each surrounding affects the installation through wall colours, framing styles, consistencies or differences, lighting, arrangements & the scale & overall space. We will discuss the various mediums of art, time periods & influences taking a glimpse into other ideas & other worlds of art to become more enlightened in art.
