

Watercolour – Continuing Intermediate

Watercolour is a beautiful, flexible and thrilling medium. Layers of translucent washes applied over white paper give it a jewel like brilliance which is unmatched by any other medium.

The Continuing Intermediate watercolour class is a continuance of the Intermediate class with the onus on practicing the techniques learned. Planning will be a significant part of these sessions. You must have the skill to execute all the basic watercolour techniques at the intermediate level to comfortably produce paintings.

The students will spend more time on expanding their knowledge through practice as they apply the techniques to an actual work. The students will be required to provide the works from pictures they own. The Instructor will work with the students and suggest best practices to accomplish their goal of the finished product. The Instructor will present challenges through some of the theory of watercolour.

The students will be required to come up with the methodology to complete a specific work which they own or as supplied by the Instructor if required. The student and Instructor will work hand in hand on how the works will be accomplished by identifying milestones, which will be monitored by both Instructor and student.

The Instructor on occasion will challenge the class with a specific work that he/she feels will draw out a skill previously learned.

Materials List:

- Bring all your existing supplies required from Intermediate level of classes – paper, brushes, paints on palette, backing boards
- Don't forget – masking tape, containers, pencil, eraser, old towel, toilet paper, old ballpoint pen, mixing plate.
