

*Drawing People & Places in Winnipeg*

In this class we will tour interesting locales around Winnipeg in order to observe and capture our surroundings on paper. The class will involve a variety of exercises to gather inspiration from, and to practice drawing, the environments as we see them. We will apply what we observe towards imaginative work in which creativity takes the forefront. Techniques, such as draw-as-you-go, will be taught to capture such moments.

Class will be open to suggestion and will be flexible to new ideas, as I believe that learning works best when ideas can be exchanged. The media will be varied but will tend towards what is portable and easy to bring on-the-go.

I will be judging the pace of the class on the first few sessions, and will attempt to take the class's interests into account when choosing the locations we will gravitate to. Small assignments may be peppered throughout the course as work to continue outside of class, some of which may be self-directed work.
