

Children's Art (7 – 11 years) - Multi-Media

During the ten-week session the children will experiment with various mediums. They will draw, paint and sculpt. They will even try out some basic animation. The following is a class outline. However, the projects may not follow in this order.

1. Drawing:

We will explore line and shadow using pencil and charcoal.

2. Painting:

We will explore colour mixing and various painting techniques.

3. Clay:

We will explore the possibilities of clay.

4. Plastercine:

We will explore how plastercine can be used to create beautiful illustrations.

5. Print making:

We will explore the process of block printing.

6. Animation:

We will learn some of the basics of animation.

7. Clay continued:

We will see how our projects turned out. We will add some paint to those creations!

8. A lesson from the Masters:

We will have a look at one of the great artists of the past. We will explore their style and try copy some of their techniques.

9. Art Show:

We will display some of the pieces we have worked on for family and friends to view.

10. Sculpture:

We will try to create a 3D piece using found and recycled materials.

Parents are invited to stay during any of the classes with their children. They may be asked to assist the instructor with art related tasks. The lunchroom & library are always open.
