

Acrylic & Canvas Adventures – Beginner/Intermediate

Over the ten week session we will be exploring & experimenting with the acrylic paint medium. We may try various techniques of application on canvas & possibly other backings such as fabrics or meshes. We will start our exploration on regular stretched canvas. We will start in the traditional way of applying paint & approaching composition but may then veer off into more experimental trials. This will be a creative method to experimentation in art & may become more of a mixed media type of art.

Materials List:

- 3 or 4 large stretched canvases
- Brushes – bring what you have to start & we'll discuss what to use. If you don't have any they can be borrowed at the first class.
- Palette – can use standard purchased palette or other options such as large corningware plates, flat covered plastic containers, etc.
- Water containers – can be used margarine containers
- Several rags, paper towels
- Paints: the basics include:
 - Cadmium Red Medium
 - Cadmium Yellow Medium
 - Cobalt Blue
 - Titanium White
 - Raw or Burnt Umber
 - Pthalo Blue
- Other supplies & paints may be included & these will be discussed at the classes depending on the direction of your work.
