

Learn to Model the Human Head in Clay – All Skill Levels **Instructor: Bill Shoup**

Please note: this same 5 week class will be offered twice during the 10 week session of classes

Discover the techniques & tricks of the trade by a master at sculpture. Bill is very comfortable at sculpting full scale heads, busts, small scale bodies, animals & vases with sculpted insets.

In this 5 week session of classes you will be concentrating on modeling the human head. Instruction will be very hands on & provide you with the ability to build a properly proportioned human head. You'll discuss & learn the process, the clay, the tools & the firing of the clay.

All levels of experience are welcome – beginners to advanced students.

Materials List:

- Please note: There is an additional fee of \$15 for firing.**
- Box of clay - approx. 44 lbs. (packed in two bags) Bill uses Plainsman, low fire L211. This is available at Sounding Stone, 104 Trottier Bay off Chevrier off Pembina Hwy, ph: 284-2964
- Full apron or other protective cover-up - an old bath towel with a pin works as well.
- Hand tools – clay modeling tools will be available to use for the first class. You will discuss with the instructor some of the tools that you may want to purchase.

- Glazes - to be discussed with instructor
