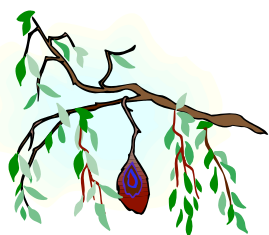

Fee: **\$125** (includes registration fee)



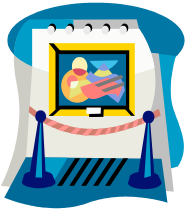
